With this in mind, SET offers an expansive online library, available to SET members. The collection comprises a wide range of national and international eBooks allowing you to deepen your teaching and training expertise.


eBook library overview and subject areas

How to access SET's online eBook library

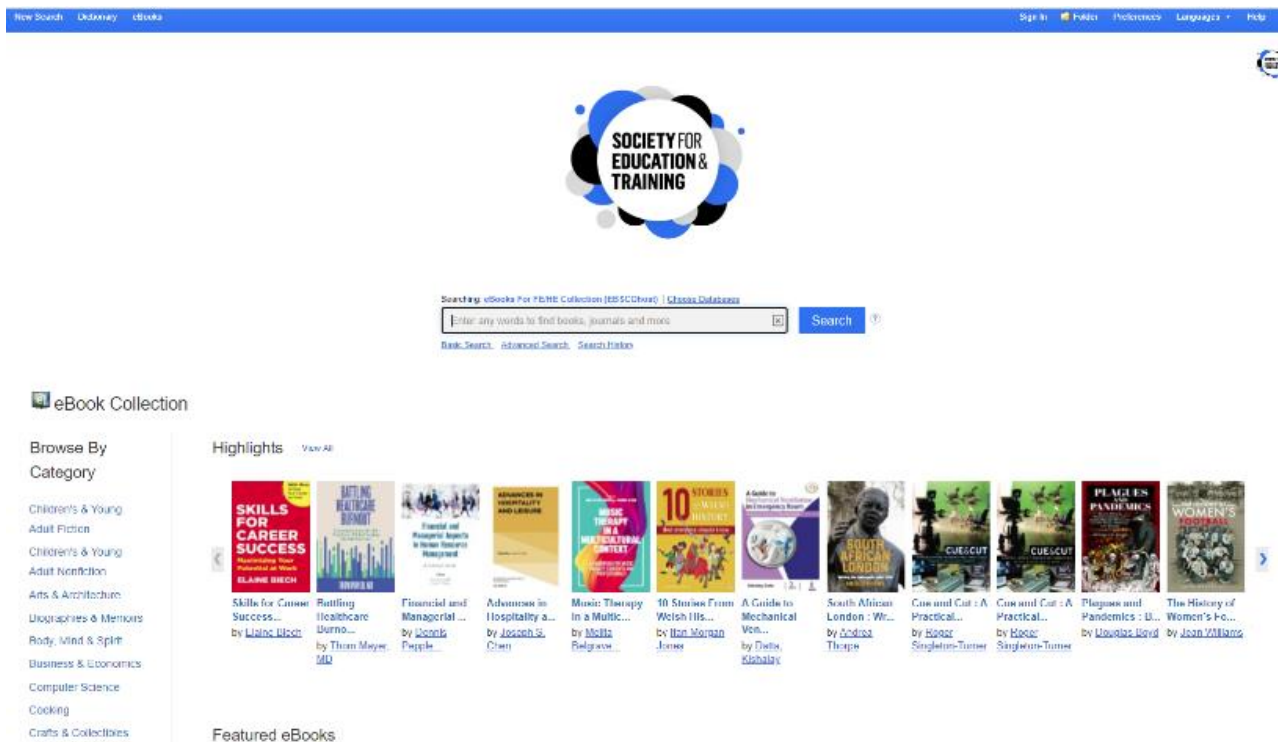
1. Access the eBook library via [Online Library | society for Education and Training \(et-foundation.co.uk\)](https://www.societyforeducationandtraining.co.uk/online-library) and click on 'Access the online FE/He library' as shown below (you need to be logged in).
